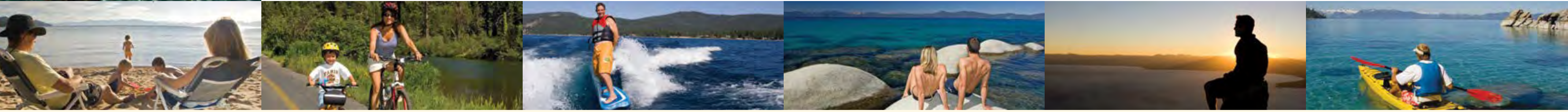
- Take a scenic Aerial Tram ride to the top of Squaw Valley and swim, dine or hike
